Workshop on Capital vs. Labor: Perspectives on Inequality and Taxation in the 21st Century

7-8 June 2024, University of St. Gallen, Switzerland

This workshop aims to bring together cutting-edge research from economics that investigates the capital-labor nexus by analyzing the effectiveness and ramifications of redistributive mechanisms, as well as to shed new light on the structure and evolution of income and wealth distributions. The themes below are indicative:

- Income and wealth inequality (empirics, mechanisms, and normative aspects)
- Optimal redistribution (e.g., capital versus wealth taxation)
- The role of technological change and AI on capital and labor
- Return heterogeneity
- The functional income distribution.

Submission details. We invite submissions by April 15th, 2024. Each author may submit only one paper (or abstract) for consideration to <u>valured@unisg.ch</u>. The submission must be original and unpublished. Acceptance will be communicated by April 20. Presenters will be invited to submit their manuscript/ abstract for consideration for a special issue on inequality and taxation of the *European Economic Review* (EER).

Organizational details. The workshop is financed by the ERC Starting Grant "VALURED" (804104), led by the principal investigator Paolo Piacquadio. Participation is free; accommodation and social dinner are covered for the presenters of accepted papers.
