



The Standard Model of Law and Economics


- An entrepreneur considers a coal mining venture
- Let the net returns from coal mining be B
- The venture is worthwhile if *B*>0



- Now govt. declares mining illegal
- Probability of getting caught = p
- Fine = F
- The venture is worthwhile if B > pF
- Or, coal mining will not be worthwhile if $B \le pF$

In sum

• Once we take account of all people in society—the citizens, the police, the judge, the politicians and the prime minister--the law cannot change the game that is being played




